- 1. None of the funds of the Club are subject to any restriction regarding their use and they are available for application on the general purposes of the Club.
- 2. The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice "Accounting by Charities" issued by the Charity Commission in 2005.
- 3. Income from members' subscriptions, ticket sales, programme sales and advertising, donations and Gift Aid is accounted for in the year to which it relates.
- 4. Interest is accounted for as it accrues.
- 5. The capital value of the Charities Fixed Interest Fund bond is adjusted to reflect its value at the 30th April 2021.
- 6. Expenditure is accounted for when the liability arises.
