Explanatory note concerning notification of third part events

As explained at the AGM on 26 June 2019, members of the Committee occasionally get notice from third parties of local music events that might be of interest to members. Since GDPR was introduced last year, the Committee has refrained from notifying these external events to members because they are not run by the Club itself, so promoting them to members, without consent, would be contrary to the Club's GDPR commitments. In particular:

- The Privacy Statement says that a member's data "*might be needed to manage your membership of the Club and to organise and run our activities. ...We will never use your data for anything else unless you give us your active consent for that additional use*"
- Paragraph 4.2.4 of the Data Protection Policy says "*Data collected will only ever be used in the way described and consented to (e.g. the Club will not use email data in order to market 3rd-party events or products unless this has been explicitly consented to)*".

At the AGM, the following points were explained:

1. The number of such events each year is very modest, probably around 5.
2. Notice of such events would be sent out to consenting members by the Club itself, so there would be no question of the Club sharing members' data with third parties.
3. Consent needs to be individual, so only members giving consent would receive these notifications.

Due to the practicalities of the Committee giving such notifications, which are often at short notice, the notifications will only be sent by email and, in any event, will always be at the Committee's discretion.
